The inspection and report will cover the following areas:

Structure and Basement, Roof cover and Drainage, Exterior, Plumbing, Heating and Air Conditioning, Electric panel, Kitchen, Interior, Attic, Insulation and Ventilation. Specific inspections may added to this agreement. (e.g. radon,water, pest, etc).

It is understood and agreed that the inspection will be conducted of readily accessible areas of the building and is limited to visual observations of apparent conditions existing at the time of the inspection only. Latent and concealed defects and deficiencies are excluded from the inspection.

Equipment and machinery will not be dismantled. This is not an inspection that to determine compliance with governmental codes and regulations of any kind. Excluded from the inspection are environmental hazards(e.g.inground fuel tanks, mold, radon, toxic or flammable chemicals etc.) Swimming pools, septic systems, private water supplies, central vacuum systems, sprinkler systems, termites and other wood destroying insects and/or rodents. All of the excluded items listed may be available in separate inspections not included in the basic home inspection being provided.
